We hereby inform you that according to the following regulations:

- 1. **EU REACH 1907/2006 211 SVHC** as of January 2021: The Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) Regulation requires the identification of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) contained in articles above the threshold 0.1% w/w manufactured and marketed in the EU (Legal Reference EC 1907/2006).
- 2. **RoHS 2 Directive 2011/65/EU** identifying six hazardous substances and EU Directive 2015/863 Amendment to RoHS 2 adding four specific phthalate substances. (Legal Reference: Directive (EU) 2015/863)

Sotras **<u>does</u>** *not import, manufacture or distributes components within chemical substances or preparations (SVHC) that need pre-registration or registration under REACH.*

REACH Candidate Substances of Very High Concern **ARE NOT CONTAINED** in our Products, in other words, our products <u>**do NOT contain**</u> chemical substances or preparations (SVHC) that may be released during normal and reasonably foreseeable conditions of use, in particular <u>**do NOT contain ASBESTOS**</u> or asbestos by products.

Furthermore, about **Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) Section 6(h)**: the mentioned above products do not contain the following substances as part of the formulation:

- PIP (3:1) phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1) (CAS no.: 68937-41-7)
- DecaBDE decabromodiphenyl ether (CAS no.: 1163-19-5)
- HCBD hexachlorobutadiene (CAS no.: 87-68-3)
- PCTB pentachlorothiophenol (CAS no.: 133-49-3)
- TTBP 2,4,6-tris(tert-butyl)phenol (CAS no.: 732-26-3)

However we assure you that we have carried out with our suppliers an information process aimed at excluding and, where needed, at handling the presence of very high concern substances (SVHC) that may be included in the future into Annex XV of REACH Regulation.
